- discrimination, including that based on sex, race, religion, disability, sexual orientation, gender identity or other.
- being in possession of, uses or supplies a suspected illegal/restricted substance
- being in possession of, or using weapons including knives (excluding Kirpans, in line with guidance set out in Legal Issues Bulletin 22 – Knives in schools) and firearms
- using an implement as a weapon
- seriously threatening or engaging in physically violent behaviour
- engaging in sexual harassment, sexual assault or other sexualised behaviour that may pose a risk of or has caused physical, psychological or emotional harm to others (see definition)

<u>Technology based:</u>

- Breaching technology guidelines and policies by harassing, humiliating, intimidating, annoying or threatening any member of the school community

Level 4 (Any level 4 behaviour)

Other consequences may include loss of privileges (leadership badges, PSSA team withdrawal etc.), warning of suspension, issued with a suspension, or any other appropriate consequence

An LST referral will be made to support the students in conjunction with classroom teacher, LST and parent/carer. Adjustments will be made to personalise a behaviour plan.

Parents/carers contacted by executive teacher – letter of concern sent/home and level entered into School Bytes

If suspended:

- Principal to contact DEL to communicate suspension
- Principal to contact parents to communicate suspension
- Department procedures for the Suspension and Expulsion of school students will be strictly adhered to
- Prior to the student returning to school a case conference will occur with relevant personnel
- Work provided by class teacher to be completed by student while on suspension
- An informal behaviour monitoring by the Principal upon returning to Expected Behaviour Level
- In extenuating circumstances extra playground supervision and adjustments may need to be provided to support the student's transition to school.
