

LEVELS	REASONS	ACTIONS
<p><b>PLEASE NOTE:</b> This system works for the majority of students; however, may be adjusted based on the individual needs of students at the discretion of the Principal and Assistant Principals (AP)</p> <p><b>** Sentral is a secure cloud-based data base where documentation on students is stored. Playground and Classroom incidents are entered into Sentral to monitor behaviour.</b></p>		
<p><b>Level 0</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All students begin on this level</li> <li>Consistently exhibit the behaviours that are expected</li> <li>Display self-discipline and are responsible</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Are recognised and reinforced for their positive behaviour</li> <li>Move through the Award system</li> <li>Student starts fresh on Level 0, after all the actions have been followed through.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Level 1 Warning</b> <b>1 week</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Student is causing concern (1 major (AP to confirm) or 3 incidents in one week-5 school days)</li> <li>Student is starting to exhibit inappropriate behaviour in the classroom or playground</li> <li>If any further incidents within the term student will be placed on Level 1.</li> <li>If Major and severe may go straight to Level 2 (principal discretion)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Assistant Principal (AP) to discuss behaviour concerns with parent and document into Sentral. Explain to parent reasons and actions.</li> <li>Student walks with a teacher for <b>2 days</b> with a 5-minute break for recess and a 10-minute break for lunch.</li> <li>Student plays in the canteen area only for following <b>3 days</b>.</li> <li>A student can only receive one Level 1 Warning in a term.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Level 1</b> <b>2 weeks</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Student is continuing to cause concern (1 major (AP to confirm or at Principal discretion) or exceeds 3 incidents in one week)</li> <li>Student is continuing to exhibit inappropriate behaviour in the classroom or playground</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>AP to discuss behaviour concerns with parent and document into Sentral</li> <li>Teacher to check-in with student daily and report to AP if concerned.</li> <li>Student walks with a teacher for <b>5 days</b> with a 5-minute break for recess and a 10-minute break for lunch.</li> <li><b>Week 2</b> – 5-day probation period, student to play in canteen area only.</li> <li>Student is unable to participate in PSSA for 2 weeks (2 days). If student is absent or PSSA cancelled on the weeks of Level 1 student will miss the next day of PSSA.</li> <li>Student may attend Dance but must make up the missed days of walking with the teacher.</li> <li>Loss of privileges for 2 weeks (10 days) (E.g. no access to Year 6 area)</li> <li>If a student has been on Level 1 throughout the term – they miss out on the PBL Reward Day during the term.</li> <li>If student is absent or has an extracurricular activity on any day of the consequence it will be made up when the student returns to school or the following day.</li> <li></li> </ul>
<p><b>Level 2</b> <b>4 weeks</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Student is continuing to cause concern (1 major (AP to confirm or at Principal discretion) or exceeds 3 incidents in one week)</li> <li>Student is continuing to exhibit inappropriate behaviour in the classroom or playground</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Documentation into Sentral continues.</li> <li>Principal to discuss concerns with parent. Letter sent home indicating level and school expectations.</li> <li><b>1<sup>st</sup> Week (5 days)</b> – student to miss out on recess and lunch in Reflection room, with a 5-minute break for recess and a 10-minute break for lunch.</li> <li><b>2<sup>nd</sup> Week (5 days)</b> – students walk with teacher for recess and lunch in the canteen area, with a 5-minute break for recess and a 10-minute break for lunch.</li> <li>Student is unable to participate in PSSA for 4 Weeks (4 days). If student is absent or PSSA cancelled on the weeks of Level 2 student will miss the next day of PSSA.</li> <li>Student may attend Dance but must make up the missed session of walking with the teacher.</li> <li>Student is unable to attend PBL Reward Day during the term.</li> <li>Teacher discusses strategies with AP to help support student in the classroom.</li> <li>Loss of privileges for 4 weeks (20 days)(E.g. Year 6 = job taken away, no access to Year 6 area, Captain, Sport Captain, SRC badge to be taken away while on Level 2)</li> <li>Placed on a Behaviour Card for 2 weeks (10 days), monitored by teacher and AP</li> </ul>

<p><b>Level 3 Serious</b></p> <p><b>6 weeks</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Continuing above behaviours</li> <li>• Continual disruptive / serious behaviour</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pre-suspension warning letter sent home indicating all the actions below and requesting a parent interview with Principal.</li> <li>• A Behaviour Response Plan is created by classroom teacher in consultation with LS teacher and parent. A copy of this is given to AP and Principal and put into Sentral.</li> <li>• <b>Week 1 (5 days)</b>- Student on Playground withdrawal in the Reflection room, where they learn strategies to help minimise problem behaviour</li> <li>• <b>Week 2 (5 days)</b>- Student walks with teacher on canteen, with a 5-minute break for recess and a 10-minute break for lunch.</li> <li>• <b>Week 3 (5 days)</b>- Student walks with teacher for recess (5-minute break) and half of lunch in the canteen area. Student must play in canteen area only.</li> <li>• Student is unable to participate in PSSA for 6 Weeks (6 days). If student is absent or PSSA cancelled on the weeks of Level 3 student will miss the next day of PSSA.</li> <li>• Student may attend Dance but must make up the missed session of walking with the teacher.</li> <li>• Student is unable to attend PBL Reward Day during the term.</li> <li>• Behaviour card monitored by AP or Principal for 3 weeks (15 days) with gradual return to the playground.</li> <li>• Permanent loss of Captain, Sport Captain, and SRC badges, Year 6 area and jobs.</li> </ul>
<p><b>SUSPENSION</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Consistently displaying Level 3 behaviours</li> <li>• Severe and unsafe behaviours</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Principal to contact parents to communicate suspension</li> <li>• Department procedures for the Suspension and Expulsion of school students will be strictly adhered to</li> <li>• Prior to the student returning to school a case conference will occur with relevant personnel</li> <li>• Work provided by class teacher to be completed by student while on suspension</li> <li>• An informal behaviour monitoring by the Principal upon returning to Level 0</li> <li>• In extenuating circumstances extra playground supervision and adjustments may need to be provided to support the student's transition to school.</li> </ul>
